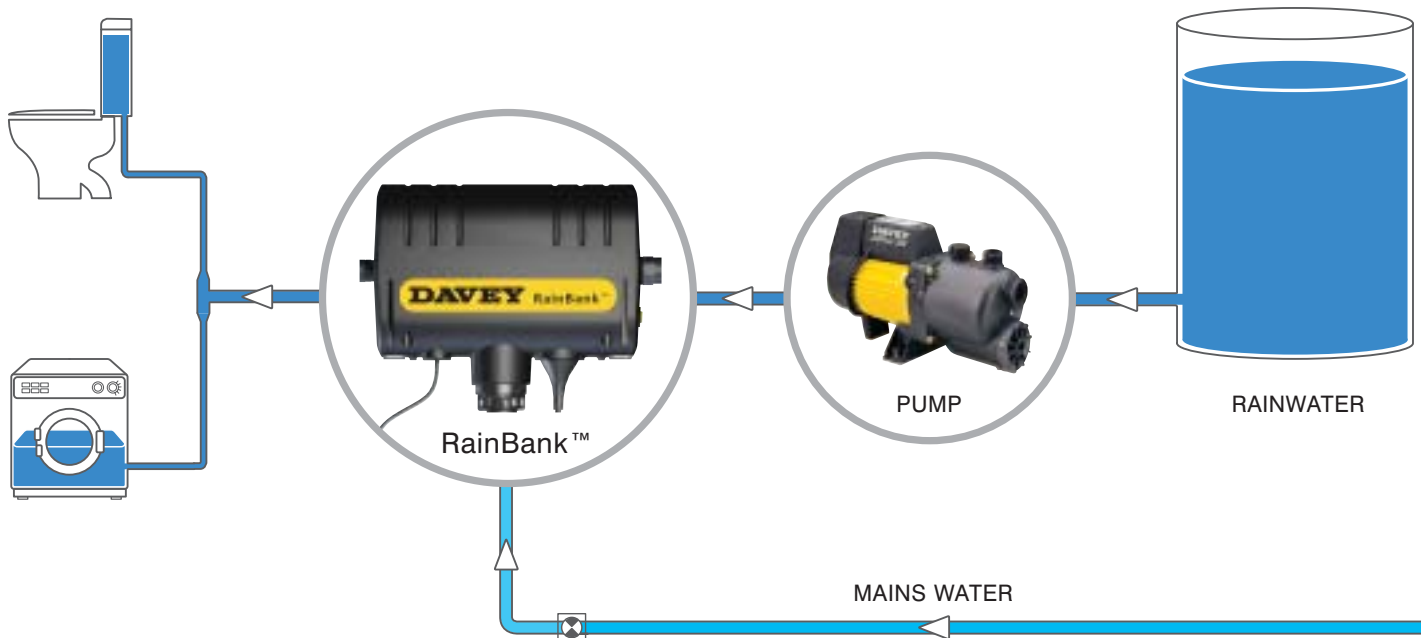

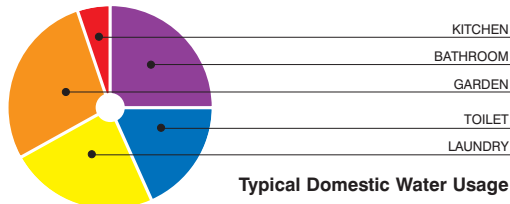

Water Saving

Why use valuable potable mains water for your toilet or laundry? Depending on rainfall, roof area and the size of tank, a RainBank can allow you to replace up to 40% of your household potable or drinking water usage with rainwater. Because RainBank is working all year round you can save water even during winter. That means a small capacity rainwater tank can be filled and emptied many times a year, allowing for smaller space saving tank designs.

Seamless and Convenient

With RainBank you don't have to worry about where your water is coming from – it does the thinking for you – automatically. RainBank automatically decides to source rainwater first and then mains water only as a back-up.

Unlike most other systems, even in the event of a power failure, RainBank can still provide water for your toilet. Even in the unlikely event of a mains water interruption, you can manually start the pump using RainBank to supply the rainwater you have.

Environmentally Friendly

RainBank only operates the pump to pressurise the rainwater when required. There's no double handling or re-pressurising of the mains water – saving you energy costs.

RainBank doesn't even use power in standby.

By installing a RainBank system you can also help top-up the public water storage reservoirs. Each time you use rainwater instead of mains water, you are helping make the mains water last longer.

As another benefit, because RainBank is using water even when it's raining, your rainwater tank can help reduce the load on the stormwater system. Your rainwater tank becomes a stormwater calming device.

Easy to Install

RainBank can be used to control an existing pump or can be matched to a new Davey pump. It can be part of a new installation or an upgrade. RainBank can be mounted on a wall or connected directly to the pump.

RainBank is very easy to install, with three simple plumbing connections, power in and out via three-pin plug and socket and a low voltage line to the rainwater tank level sensor.

By connecting the unit in compliance with the instructions and the Australian/New Zealand plumbing code you are ensuring the integrity of your potable supply. After all, millions of Australasians drink rainwater every day. All electrical items in RainBank are approved and manufactured to ensure your safety.
